Office-in-a-box

Office-in-a-Box is a fully self-contained business system meeting all the server requirements of businesses, up to 100 users, at extremely attractive pricing.

Incorporated into Office-in-a-Box are Microsoft Windows compliant file and print shares organised in such a way as to easily enable connection of Microsoft Windows-based computers. All versions from Windows/95 right up to Windows/XP and Vista are supported. This means that almost any computer running Windows will be able to save files to network drives managed by Office-in-a-Box. Additionally, computers will be able to print to any printer either connected directly to, or managed by, Office-in-a-Box.

Office-in-a-Box connects to the Internet via any standard router/firewall. If required, Office-in-a-Box can be set up to restrict your user's access to the Internet by requiring them to have a password. Additionally, a list of prohibited sites can be maintained.

Office-in-a-Box can act as a mail server enabling full support for direct delivery of e-mail (the fastest configuration). You can also collect e-mail from your ISP if you prefer. If you have multiple domains (e-mail identities) these can be accommodated. Access to your e-mail is via your preferred client, including Microsoft Outlook. Remote access to your e-mail, via your web browser, is available as standard. Antivirus software is included by default.

If you want to host your own company web server Office-in-a-Box has Apache built in and development can be done with a number of well-known software tools including Microsoft Frontpage or Dreamweaver. Office-in-a-Box supports FTP for uploading your changes. Apache supports a range of common scripting languages including Java & Perl.

Need to manage your data more effectively? Office-in-a-Box has SQL built in and you can use Microsoft Access as the client via an ODBC connector giving superb performance using familiar software.

A web-based administration tool allows management either from the local network or

remotely. Training courses are available to enable you to manage the system yourself or, alternatively, comprehensive support agreements, competitively priced, are available incorporating all the support you will ever need.

Office-in-a-Box can do a lot more, in fact with Office-in-a-box the only other technology you need are standard PCs to plug into it.

Technical Specifications

Office-in-a-box runs on a range of hardware platforms from major vendors including Dell and HP. Entry level systems for 5-10 users can be implemented on a relatively modest hardware platform and the system is fully scalable up to hundreds of users.

File sharing is achieved using CIFS (Common Internet File System) which is the well-known SMB file system built into all versions of Microsoft Windows. This means your applications will connect to Office-in-a-Box seamlessly. Printer sharing is handled in exactly the same way with support provided for directly connected or network printers using the well known JetDirect card or compatible. All versions of Windows connect to Office-in-a-Box without modification.



Office-in-a-Box requires an Internet connection with a single static IP address for full functionality to be enabled. Office-in-a-Box provides:

- File & Print services
- Web hosting
- E-mail hosting
- MySQL database
- Firewall
